Focus – finalising plans for community Big Lunch for Artington on Sunday 10th June 2018

1. Food and drink

- Jennie Wisher has placed order for sausages & burgers. Final order:
 - Additive Free Pork Sausages – 60p each - for 180 = £108
 - Additive Free Beef Burgers - £1.00 each - for 100 = £100

Jennie to collect and pay. Need to check packaging as to whether cool boxes required.

- Vegan food & condiments to be purchased from supermarket – CT
- Bread – Fiona Clayton to purchase from supermarket. 15 packs of subs and 15 packs of baps 6x white, 7x wholemeal.
- BBQ's – 2x charcoal from Caper & Berry for main food cooking. 1x gas from Tafts for vegetarian food.
- Cooks – volunteers in place, anyone who wants to help very welcome.
- Ale – Roger Musson has purchased from Rudgwick - will collect with Nick Taft on Saturday. CC to pay RM. Charge on day of £2.50 per pint or £10 as much as you like.
- Squash purchased by CT.
- Jacque Stanford has tableware.
- All else supplied by attendees as previously agreed.

2. Entertainment

3. Activities
