2. **Disclosure of interests**

3. **Minutes**
The minutes of the annual parish council meeting held on 13th January 2014 were signed as an accurate record.
4. **Matters arising** RM
 - Chairman to write to James Palmer (GBC) to suggest that an open forum meeting be held to discuss the draft report on the projected number of houses in Guildford Borough for the Local Plan purposes.
5. **Current planning application** RM

Orange Grove, Littleton Lane (GBC ref: 14/P/00073)

 - The plans were viewed, discussed and it was resolved that APC would raise no objections.
6. **Parking at The Ridges** SK
 - A letter has been sent to the Chief Constable from the residents of The Ridges asking her to deal with the parking issues in the area. A copy will be sent to Chris Jackson (Facilities Manager) who has previously been very supportive.
 - The residents now find the problem of inconsiderate parking has gone beyond an inconvenience and annoyance to become a potential safety issue.
 - It was agreed that the fundamental shortage of parking, sufficient for the requirements of Mount Browne needs to be addressed.
 - The parish council will send a letter reiterating these concerns, supporting the letter from The Ridges residents. RM
7. **Parish party** JS
 - The suggestion of another summer party has been well received.
 - The proposed date is Sunday 1st June afternoon/evening
 - It will be held in the centre of Littleton, in the field where the royal oak is planted and it is hoped that Sultanas will again be able to perform.
8. **Annual parish meeting** RM
 - The University of Law have kindly agreed to host our next Annual Parish Meeting, for which the favoured date is Wednesday 7th May, subject to agreement by the University.
