



- *New Pond Road railway bridge*

A meeting about the replacement of the bridge is to be held at Loseley on 27<sup>th</sup> November.

- *Stakescorner Road posts*

Jason Lewis of SCC Highways has fixed reflectors onto the posts in Stakescorner Road and has undertaken to replace those posts that have been damaged by the verge cutting machinery.

- *Stakescorner Road speed limit.*

Cllr Johnson said that the application for an extension to the 30mph speed limit in Stakescorner Road is included in a report that will go to committee in the new year.

- *Access-only and Community Speed Watch surveys*

There have been no surveys undertaken recently.

10. **Risk of falling trees**

Following damage to a building caused by a falling tree, APC has been advised that any residents who are worried about particular trees should write to the landowner to advise them of their concerns.

The clerk was asked to seek the advice of the GBC arboricultural officer about trees in the parish. PG

11. **Report from Cllr George Johnson (SCC)**

In addition to the matters above, Cllr Johnson reported that the proposed Crossrail 2 will be coming into Surrey as far as Epsom. This will release capacity on the Waterloo railway line that, he hopes, could be utilised to create a direct route from the Guildford area to Heathrow Airport. PG

- It was resolved that the parish council should renew its subscription to the Surrey Hills Society.

13. **Loseley matters**

Cllr More-Molyneux reported that:

- Strutt & Parker have been appointed as the new agents for the Loseley estate.
- The Rural Craft Association show will take place on 19-22 November. Access via Stakescorner Road.
- The Hog's Back Road Race will take place on the morning of Sunday 6th December.
- Network Rail has postponed its work on the railway line that would require access via Loseley land and Stakescorner Road.
- The estate has applied for permission to create a farm shop at Mellersh Farm, Compton.

14. **Litterpick**

- Cllr Kitson has arranged for a litter pick to take place on Saturday 12th December. Anyone wishing to take part should contact him on 07951 045250.

15. **Planning**

- *Heathwood Cottage, Sandy Lane*

The councillors made no comment.

- *Wonersh House, Old Portsmouth Road*

The councillors were concerned about increased light pollution that would be created by the proposed illuminated sign. They asked that it be made a condition of approval that the sign be turned off at night. PG

The clerk will write to GBC.

- *Beechwood House, Sandy Lane*

The councillors made no comment.

- *Hollowfield Cottage, Littleton*

[The applicant, Cllr Musson, left the meeting before discussion of this item].

The councillors unanimously agreed to make no comment about the application itself but concern was expressed about possible disruption that could arise during the construction of the building. This should be covered by the Construction Management Plan to be written by the contractor and councillors asked that they be consulted about its proposals.
